Motion by Hartz, supported by Ouellette to add the approval of the Contract Modification for the Dickerson Road Project as agenda item #5.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Hartz to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and to accept them as presented.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnson, supported by Hartz to excuse Council Member Sharrard from tonight's meeting.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Ms. Paige Switalski, Leadership Otsego County, asked questions of City Council members regarding their service on City Council.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt to allow the Santa Parade on December 1, 2018.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Witt to do nothing at this time regarding the MRTMA. No second was given and the motion lapsed.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Wishart to have the City Attorney draft an ordinance prohibiting marihuana establishments in the City as well as an ordinance prohibiting the use of marihuana in public places.

Ayes: Ouellette, Hartz, Jenkins, and Wishart. Nays: Johnson and Witt. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnson, supported by Hartz to send a resolution of support for the petitioners filing complaints against the new MDEQ Lead and Copper Rules.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnson, supported by Ouellette to approve the Contract Modification of (\$21,163.41) for the Dickerson Road Project.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

No other business was presented and the meeting was adjourned at 8:22 p.m.
