Sec. 4401. ELIMINATOR REQUIRED.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, corporation or partnership to operate any electrical motor or any other electrical apparatus within the City of Gaylord, County of Otsego, and State of Michigan, without having attached thereto an eliminator or apparatus which shall eliminate all interference with radio or television reception.

Sec. 4402. UNLAWFUL EQUIPMENT AND OPERATIONS.

No person shall operate a radio or television receiving or transmitter set in such a manner as to cause interference with other radio and television receiving sets, nor shall any person maintain on his premises, or attached thereto, any receiving set so installed or constructed as to cause interference with other radio and television receiving sets. No person shall attach to the antennae, or other suspended wires, or other parts of a radio or television receiving set, any form of electrical apparatus, excepting broadcasting equipment licensed by the United States Government that does in any manner cause interference to other radio or television receiving sets.

Sec. 4403. VIOLATION AND PENALTY.

Any person convicted of violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as provided in Section 1104 (See 12.028) of this Code.
