

20.000 **TRAFFIC; ADOPTION OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE**
CITY OF GAYLORD, MICHIGAN
Ord. Eff. January 10, 2000
Amend. Eff. April 14, 2003

An ordinance to adopt by reference, the Michigan Vehicle Code and to repeal prior Sections 20.000 through 20.004 of the General Code of the City of Gaylord.

THE CITY OF GAYLORD ORDAINS:

20.001 **Sec. 1. MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE AND AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS**
ADOPTED.

The Michigan Vehicle Code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 TO 257.923, and all future amendments and revisions to the Michigan Vehicle Code when they are effective in this state are incorporated and adopted by reference.

20.002 **Sec. 2. REFERENCES IN VEHICLE CODE.**

References in the Michigan Vehicle Code to "local authorities" shall mean the City of Gaylord.

20.003 **Sec. 3. NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED.**

The City clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall publish at the same time, a notice stating the purpose of the Michigan Vehicle Code and the fact that a complete copy of the code is available to the public at the office of the Clerk for inspection.

20.004 **Sec. 4. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED.**

Prior Sections 20.000 through 20.004 of the General Code of the City of Gaylord are hereby specifically repealed.

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the Michigan Vehicle Code are, to the extent of any inconsistencies, hereby repealed.

20.005 **Sec. 5. PENALTIES.**

The penalties provided by the Michigan Vehicle Code are adopted by reference, provided however, that the City may not enforce any provisions of the Michigan Vehicle Code for which the maximum period of imprisonment is greater than 93 days.
