

**20.300 UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS ON SCHOOL PREMISES
OR SURROUNDING SCHOOL GROUNDS, ETC.
CITY OF GAYLORD, MICHIGAN**

**20.301 Sec. 4501. DUTY OF PERSON CREATING DISTURBANCES TO LEAVE ON
REQUEST OF PRINCIPAL.**

Any person found to be creating a disturbance in private, public or parochial school or on the surrounding school grounds, or on fields or recreational areas or other grounds lawfully used for school activities while such activities are in progress, shall immediately leave when so directed by the principal or by any other person designated by the principal.

**20.302 Sec. 4502. UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS NOT TO ENTER OR REMAIN IN
SCHOOL BUILDINGS; CURFEW HOURS FOR SCHOOL PROPERTY;
PROHIBITION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.**

- a. No person shall enter and remain in any public, private, or parochial school building between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on days such school is in session, who is not a regularly enrolled student, teacher or other employee at such school, unless he shall have first immediately proceeded to the administrative offices and identified himself to the principal or the principal's designee. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter and remain in any public, private or parochial school, or on surrounding school grounds within 500 feet of the school building, after being requested to leave by the principal or his designee.
- b. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or loiter on or in any public, private or parochial school, or on surrounding school grounds, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., unless there is a school activity in progress or unless the person is an employee of such school or school system.
- c. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume or possess alcohol or alcoholic beverages in or upon the surrounding grounds of any public, private or parochial school.

20.303 Sec. 4503. VIOLATION AND PENALTY.

Any person convicted of violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as provided in Section 1104 of this Code,
