Minutes

June 25, 2020

Mayor Wishart chaired the Committee and opened it up with thanking all the members of the committee for serving. The Committee members then provided a little background on themselves and their desires in serving on the Committee.

Open Discussion on Existing Ordinance

Mayor Wishart turned the meeting over to Manager Duff and Attorney Slough who took the Committee through the various segments of Marihuana legislation in the State of Michigan. There was discussion on the Michigan Medical Marihuana Act (MMMA) the Michigan Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act (MMFLA) and the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (MRTMA).

Discussion on the various and unique role of municipalities and the purpose of the Committee to establish which, if any portions of the MRTMA, that the City of Gaylord should consider participation in and formulating an ordinance to so accommodate. Various license types were discussed: Growers, Class A, B, C and Microbusiness; Secure Transporter; Processors; Provisioning Centers; Safety Compliance Facilities. Impacts of Zoning and licensing by the municipality and other aspects such as impacts on policing, administration of City, and impact on utilities. Taxation and shared revenues were also discussed. The Committee members openly discussed all aspects of this new business.

Some of the discussion came down to a request by the Committee to have someone from Law Enforcement be in attendance at the next meeting. The Committee also asked to see what kind of biological impacts on water and wastewater would or could be expected from processing or grow operations. The other aspect was what projected or expected potential revenue could be expected and if there is any information available on this to share.
