Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the November 11th, 2019 meeting and accept them as presented.

Public Comment: Mark Hansen, 615 West Sheldon Street, asked if a car having wheels was a requirement of the current city ordinance.

Motion by Johnson, supported by Witt to approve the Solicitation Permit for the Salvation Army.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Wishart to approve the purchase and placement of two flashing signs on North Otsego Avenue near St Mary School with the school sharing in 25% of the cost to purchase and the placement of an additional street light at the City's expense.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt to approve the Santa Parade for December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 5:30pm.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt to approve the three year contract extension with BioTech Agronomics for sludge removal from the Waste Water Treatment Plant.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.
